Files also include notes, documents and clippings regarding the Royal Commission on Newspapers. More general files include clippings, notes,

publication planning files, correspondence, readership reports, and other editorial material. Files related to Lewis's managerial role include correspondence, staffing and personnel files, strategic, operational and budgetary planning files, and files documenting his move from Maclean's to Rogers Media. The series also contains

a puzzle that was part of a Maclean's treasure hunt contest.
